



Nurse Home Visitor

The Coalition is seeking a nurse responsible for providing comprehensive nursing services to women and their families as part of the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) grant. This is a grant-funded position and funding may be extended. A grant-funded position has no guarantee of on-going and indefinite employment.

Nurse Home Visitors are responsible for maintaining the highest standards in clinical nursing practice and adherence to the Nurse-Family Partnership Program (NFP) model, and to the policies procedures, guidelines and standards of the NFP and of the Early Learning Coalition of Polk County.

Nurse Home Visitors provide home visits to women and their families eligible for the NFP program. This position adheres to the nursing process and the NFP model of home visitation. The Nurse Home Visitor will carry a caseload of up to 25 clients.

This position requires excellent written and verbal communication skills as well as basic computer skills. This person must be available to work flexible schedules, including occasional weekend/evenings as required. A valid Florida driver's license, proof of auto insurance, availability of an automobile during work hours, and the ability to travel locally or regionally for site and home visits, nationally for training and other job related activities and functions are required.

RN with two years recent experience in maternal/child health, public health, home visiting or mental/behavioral nursing is required. Current nursing license in good standing is also required. A Bachelor's Degree in Nursing is required. For a detailed job description, [click here](#).
