



Parent Counselor

This is a professional position that provides eligibility determination and referral services to clients according to state and federal funding guidelines.

The Parent Counselor provides referral information to parents who are seeking assistance with child care matters and determines the eligibility of these parents for financially assisted child care/School Readiness (SR) and Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) services according to funding guidelines. Such duties as face-to-face interviews with prospective clients, data entry, computer support, maintaining records and files, client updates, and making telephone calls are required. The Parent Counselor will also communicate with child care providers in the community for the approval of child care services, transferring of clients from site to site, and the termination of child care services of clients. This person must be able to function as team member and work on multiple projects at the same time. The position requires excellent organization skills and advance computer literacy in a Windows environment.

This person must be available to work flexible schedules, including occasional weekend/evenings as required. A valid Florida driver's license, proof of auto insurance, availability of an automobile during work hours, and the ability to travel locally or regionally for site and home visits, training, and other job-related activities and functions are required.

This position requires a High School Diploma or equivalent. An AA degree is preferred. Requires at least 2 years of experience in case management; provision of services under a county or state contract is preferred.
