FAMILY ENGAGEMENT KITS – VENDOR FAQs

- When are the kits due to be delivered to sites? Do they all have to be delivered by October 31, 2023?
 - a. We would like Infant/Toddler and Preschool kits delivered in "batches" to providers. We will send the selected vendor a list of providers and quantity for each kit type.
 - i. Batch 1 is due October 31, 2023.
 - 1. Approximately 2,000 Infant/toddler kits
 - 2. Approximately 2,700 preschool kits
 - ii. Batch 2 is due by December 31, 2023.
 - 1. Approximately 2,000 Infant/toddler kits
 - 2. Approximately 2,700 preschool kits
 - iii. Batch 3 is due by February 28, 2024.
 - 1. Approximately 2,000 Infant/toddler kits
 - 2. Approximately 2,700 preschool kits
 - iv. Batch 4 is due by May 1, 2024.
 - 1. Approximately 6,000 VPK kits
- 2. Can the ELC be pre-billed for the kits?
 - a. The kits will be shipped to providers in four batches (see above). The selected vendor may invoice ELC for each batch.
- 3. Will kits be shipped directly to providers or to ELC?
 - a. The Infant/Toddler and Preschool kits will be shipped directly to providers. Addresses will be provided to the vendor. The VPK kits will be sent to providers and to the ELC office.
- 4. Is there a specific preference for the kit container (i.e.: clear tub/bin or backpack)?
 - a. There is no preference, but this should be specified in the proposal. The contents of each kit should be held in one container.
- 5. Is there a specific number of items requested per kit or is it most important that the kits stay at the specified price point?
 - a. There is no specific number of items, but the value of the items included at the \$150.00 price point will be considered as proposals are reviewed.
- 6. Are there specific types of items to include in each kit (i.e.: book, a puppet, activity & manipulative)?
 - a. Items that are included should promote kindergarten readiness skills such as social/emotional development, problem solving, and critical thinking skills for children ages birth – 5 years of age. Materials may include toys, games, books, music, etc.

- 7. Does the Infant/Toddler kit need to be broken down by age group or development area or can it be a single kit?
 - a. There should be a combined Infant/Toddler kit.
- 8. If the Infant/Toddler kits should be one kit, is there a specific number of items per age group?a. No, there is not a specific number of items per age group.
- 9. Is there a specific topic of focus for each kit (i.e.: literacy, math, music/movement, Social Emotional etc.)?
 - a. No, there is not a specific topic of focus.
- 10. Is it necessary for the vendor to have materials that cater to all listed age groups?
 - a. Yes, materials for the stated age groups must be included.
- 11. Can the proposal be submitted electronically?
 - a. Yes, electronic proposals are accepted.
- 12. What quantities are required for each age group?
 - a. 6,000 Infant/Toddler Family Engagement Kit (for families of infants, toddlers, and two-year-olds)
 - b. 8,000 Preschool Family Engagement Kit (for families of children ages three to five years old)
 - c. 6,000 VPK Family Engagement Kit (for families of four- and five-year-old children)
- 13. Can family instructions and guides be delivered electronically, or must it be a print version included in the kit?
 - a. The instructions must be in print form and included in each individual kit. If possible, instructions should be in both English and Spanish.
- 14. Is training required for families?
 - a. There is no training required.
